A <u>PARDON</u> is a decision made by the governor to excuse someone who has been convicted of a crime. Once the pardon is granted, the record becomes eligible for expungement. Pardons are available for all misdemeanor and felony convictions, and you can apply at any time.

Understand it is a long process (sometimes more than four years), and we recommend waiting until you:

- Have at least five years from the completion of a misdemeanor sentence and ten years from the completion of a felony sentence
- Have paid all fines, costs, and restitution related to the case
