

The SOR Homeless Housing Grant helps individuals with a history of Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) or Stimulant Use Disorder (StUD) by providing safe and affordable housing options.

Individuals will receive assistance with rent, utilities and other basic needs for up to six (6) months.

To be considered for the SOR Homeless Housing Grant, the following eligibility requirements must be met:

- Bucks County resident
- An individual or family who does not have

   or who is not able to afford stable,
   safe, permanent and appropriate housing.
